<b>Environmental Policy Statement</b>


- To comply with all relevant environmental legislation and other relevant requirements, such as industry best practice and client specifications

- To develop long-term relationships with clients which will allow sustainable, energy efficient solutions to be identified through design, manufacture and installation stages of all projects
- To prevent pollution arising from our working activities
- To achieve continual improvement in environmental performance

A systematic assessment of all environmental aspects will be conducted in order to identify the significant impacts over which the business has control. The outputs of this Aspects and Impacts Assessment will be recorded and used to determine appropriate, specific, measurable objectives which support achievement of the policy commitments detailed above. These objectives will be assigned to relevant Heads of Department by the Managing Director for implementation and reviewed for progress and completion periodically via formal Management Review meetings.

The Managing Director will assume responsibility for ensuring this policy is fully implemented, complied with and communicated. The content of this policy along with relevant information relating to environmental aspects, impacts and objectives for improvement will be communicated to the entire workforce, including sub-contractors and other interested parties via appropriate means. The policy will also be made available to the public via publication on the company website.

This policy and its effectiveness will be monitored in line with the company's Integrated Management System and reviewed annually, as a minimum, or when circumstances dictate.
